#### THE SCHOLARSHIP'S HISTORY

In 1995, S.A.R.M. auctioned off the first copy of its history book, "The Building of a Province: Commemorating the 90th Anniversary of the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities." This auction netted the sum of \$2,600 which the S.A.R.M. Board of Directors contributed to the Canadian Centre for Health and Safety in Agriculture (CCHSA).

These funds initiated the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities 90th Anniversary
\$1,000 Student Scholarship in Agricultural Safety and Rural Health.

The National Partners Fund at CCHSA maintains the scholarship.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING AWARD

- 1. The winner will be announced in March and will be asked to attend the S.A.R.M. convention to accept the award.
- Two \$1500 scholarships will be awarded to the students who submits the best farm safety essay accompanied by a completed
  application form.
- These awards are contingent upon the recipient proceeding to their first year of post secondary education in Saskatchewan. The student can be attending school outside of the province if the courses they want to take are not offered in Saskatchewan.
- Students who misrepresent themselves will be eliminated from the essay competition.

### **ESSAY REQUIREMENTS**

- **1.** Choose one of these topics for your essay:
  - 1) The Importance of Safety and Health on Our Farm
  - 2) Safety and Health Hazards on Our Farm
- **2.** Send:
- (a) One copy of the typed essay on white, 8.5" x 11" paper;
- (b) Double space and leave 1" margins;
- (c) Do not place your name on it;
- (d) The essay should be approximately 1,000 words.
- **3.** The essay should be based on your family's farming experiences rather than a research-based paper.
- 4. The essay submitted should be (a) clearly written in acceptable scholarly English, (b) and should be free of errors in spelling, grammar, and punctuation.
- 5. The essay will be judged according to (a) content (80%) and (b) correct writing style (20%).
