

INFORMATION FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER PARTICIPATION

Background: Dr. Brenna Bath from the School of Rehabilitation Science, University of Saskatchewan, and her research team, invite you to participate in this research study. [We are investigating](#) patient experiences of accessing health care for low back pain who live in rural, remote and urban areas.

Eligibility: Must be a Saskatchewan resident. Health care provider who has experience treating patients with chronic low back pain between ages 18-80 years old.

What is involved: Eligible and willing individuals will be asked to complete a short questionnaire on their practice experience as well as undergo a one-on-one online or phone interview to discuss personal experiences with providing care for those with back pain (both positive and negative); local needs for chronic back pain care; ways we might be able to measure and understand future changes to improve access to healthcare in your community. Interviews will be approximately 30 minutes.

The information you share will help us to better understand the local needs for chronic back pain care. This information will be combined with perspectives from other health care providers as well as information from rural, urban and remote patients who have experienced low back pain across Saskatchewan. We plan to share our findings with policy and decision makers, with the hope of improving access and supports to healthcare services in Saskatchewan.
